What the job involves:

The PC normally meets five times a year on a weekday evening. The meetings are held in public, and last around 90 minutes. The role of the Parish Council is to represent the views of people living in the parish on matters affecting our villages, and to make decisions about the upkeep and improvement of parish amenities.
